The sum of **100.000 €**

will be awarded to a distinguished scientist with an excellent record in neurobiology. Proposals, which will be evaluated by an international jury, should represent a comprehensive approach focusing on HSP etiology and opening up therapeutic perspectives.

Applicants should submit

- a five-page exopsé for a three year research project
- their full CV (résumé)
- a two-page summary of research record and list of key publications.
